

How should the providers treated that are in position to change the infrastructure to gain access to the personal data:

- Domain name service (DNS) providers, they can ultimately change where the internet traffic goes and monitor all data passing through. For example very popular US-based service providers like CloudFlare DNS, Godaddy, etc.
- Infrastructure technical support to systems that process personal data without them having access to personal data but they have the are in a technical position to change the infrastructure so that they could gain access to personal data
- Operating system manufacturers have the possibility to . Apple can gain access to any users personal computers screen via they remote support.
